Colleagues,

As you may have heard, all adult Texans will be eligible to schedule an appointment for a [COVID-19 vaccine](#) starting the week of March 29.

System Offices is not a vaccine provider, but SO employees interested in receiving a COVID-19 vaccine can make an appointment for themselves by checking with the approved vaccine providers in their area. If all vaccine appointments with local providers are full on your first pass, you should check back frequently.

TAMUS employees are also eligible to make an appointment with Student Health Services (SHS) at TAMU for their COVID-19 vaccine by visiting <https://shs.tamu.edu/appointments/>. NOTE: SO Employees must log in to the SHS Patient Portal with their NET ID and indicate they are "Faculty or Staff" when booking the vaccine appointment.
